Norm Miller called the meeting to order. The meeting commenced at 6:05 p.m.

The following items were addressed:

- 1. <u>Minutes</u>. Minutes for the previous 4/9/2012 regular Board meeting were approved by the Board. Motion to approve minutes were made by Jack Carney, seconded by Lynda Hendrickson and unanimously approved by the Board.
- 2. <u>Architectural Committee</u>. Lynda Hendrickson, chair, reported several items (report is attached to these minutes):
  - Request from 900 Callaway Court Charlene Anderson -- to paint the concrete floor on their front porch and back patio/breezeway to match the color of their home
  - Request from 822 Callaway Court Jan Pate for driveway extension and sidewalk.
  - Architectural committee wondered whether homes should be repainted so gables match other parts. Units were painted that way on purpose. Considered part of the style of a "Craftsman" home.

Motion to approve Architectural Committee report was made by Kenny Burnette, seconded by Jack Carney and unanimously approved by the Board.

- 3. <u>Landscape/Maintenance Committee.</u> Ursula Jenkins presented Board with the landscape/common area report. (Landscape Report attached). Several items were discussed and the Landscape Committee Report is attached to these minutes:
  - Encroachment of fence from one neighbor (Donny Howard) at Heritage Green onto our property was discussed. The homeowner was sent a letter April 25 by Jack Carney asking him to remove fence or we would have Tim Morgan remove fence at Donny Howard's expense within 30 days.
  - Copp Surveying came back out and surveyed the tree line for an additional \$200. They marked with large orange stakes. Jack Carney took pictures. There were no other encroachments from the

other side.

- Irrigation system is back on (partially). Back Flow Testers forgot to test one of our devices and did so this week of 5/14/12. All tested out and paperwork has been sent to TAWC. TB to send their irrigation specialist out to retest all sprinklers and give the board a copy of the schedule of sprinklers. They were also asked to check rain sensors to make sure they are working correctly.
- Need to check out lights in some alleyways which are on during the day. May be sensor issue. Ursula to check out and contact Rick Darwin (electrician) if that's the case.
- 731 Andrew Shaver unit need to remove and replace 2 dead bushes.
- TB to mulch around fake rock.
- Tim replace French doors at 907 and 515. Still needs to replace Teresa Smith's doors.
- 32 front porch ceilings have been cleaned/painted.
- Tim Morgan is starting painting pre-approved units. Shaffer unit 925 first.
- Gutters of 4 homes in back to be cleaned out
- 541 front porch ceiling to be cleaned
- 408 Joe Wilson unit water pipe/line leak in foundation of floor. HOA responsible for repair of water line/pipe and replacement of concrete to good working condition. Joe to be sent a letter asking him to contact his insurance company regarding replacement of inside hardwood floor/any inside damage.
- 947 Glass Doctor ordered new glass for broken window. To replace week of 5/14.

Motion to approve Landscape Committee report was made by Lynda Hendrickson, seconded by Judy Webster and unanimously approved by the Board.

4. <u>Insurance/Asset Committee.</u> Kenny Burnette gave the Insurance Asset Committee report. We reviewed the newly revised maintenance budget. (Revised budget attached to these minutes). Discussion of raising HOA dues for 2013 to \$150/per month to cover continuing expenses, maintenance issues, etc.

Motion to approve Insurance/Asset Committee report and the newly revised budget was made by Judy Webster, seconded by Jack Carney and unanimously approved by the Board.

5. <u>Treasurer Report</u>. The treasurer report was given by Judy Webster. Financials were handed out to all on Board members. (Copy of all financials attached to these minutes). Detailed discussion of financials. The Gardens look to be in excellent shape financially; however, as stated above, due to continuing expenses and maintenance issues we may need to raise dues in 2013 to \$150/per month.

Motion to approve Treasurer's Report was made by Jack Carney, seconded by Marianne Shultz and unanimously approved by Board.

6. <u>Finance Accounting Committee Report</u>. There was no finance accounting committee report this month. Was intertwined with Treasurer Report.

#### 7. Other Items for Discussion:

- (a) New HOA website The new community website was discussed. A lot of discussion on asking our vendors to join the site, pay \$10/per month to advertise and to cover cost of the website which is approximately \$50/per month. A lot of discussion on other things the new website could provide. Need to provide more pictures (of other seasons).
- (b) Speeding was discussed. We have a lot of residents with constant speeding issues. Several vehicles were identified. It was discussed the speeders are coming from within- not coming from visitors. Also, some residents speeding up and down alleyways were also identified. There was a lot of discussion of speed bumps which not one board member would like to put into place. Alternatives were discussed.

Several members of the board will keep a list of who the speeders are in the upcoming month as they see them. We discussed sending out a newsletter naming the offenders so everyone can see who would be causing the HOA to provide speed bumps. It was finally determined that for now, Judy Webster would post a large sign at the postal units that speed bumps are coming if speeding does not stop. It is dangerous to our fellow residents, pets and children and could cause the HOA a huge liability if it continues and someone is hurt. It will be discussed further next month to see if there has been any improvement.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.

- 1. <u>Minutes</u>. Minutes for the previous 3/12/2012 regular Board meeting were approved by the Board. Motion to approve minutes were made by JoAnne Harbort, seconded by Jack Carney and unanimously approved by the Board.
- 2. <u>Approval of New Secretary.</u> Marianne Schultz has agreed to be our new temporary Secretary of the Board. Motion to approve Marianne Schultz as new secretary was made by Kenny Burnette, seconded by Judy Webster and unanimously approved by the Board.
- 3. <u>Architectural Committee</u>. Lynda Hendrickson, chair, reported several items (report is attached to these minutes):
  - Request for additional concrete (sidewalk) was made by 355 Kathleen Grimes and was approved by committee.
  - Request for additional concrete (sidewalk) was made by 125 Glenda Fulgham and was approved by committee.
  - 1032 Callaway Court issue resolved regarding satellite dish on roof.

Motion to approve Architectural Committee report was made by Judy Webster, seconded by Jack Carney and unanimously approved by the Board.

- 4. <u>Landscape/Maintenance Committee.</u> Ursula Jenkins presented Board with the landscape/common area report. Several items were discussed and the Landscape Committee Report is attached to these minutes:
  - Several bushes were moved and placed in areas around the Gardens.
  - Parking issues resolved; 1014 boat/trailer, 523, trailer and white truck.

- Addressed parking in undesignated areas and car repairs being done on property, junk cars parked in our areas. Will consult with unit owners.
- Painting and washing bids received. The bid for \$5250 divided by 32 units = \$164/per unit for painting and washing of front porch ceilings.
- Turf Builders will turn on irrigation system in April/May.
- Have asked for price on sod in side yard of 1006 David Cooper's unit.
- Surveyor completed survey and to send us results to review for encroachment.
- Encroachment of fence from one neighbor at Heritage Green onto our property was discussed. The homeowner has said he will remove fence completely.

5. <u>Insurance/Asset Committee.</u> Kenny Burnette gave the Insurance Asset Committee report (which is attached to these minutes). We reviewed the budget for this year and the next 20 years with consideration of raising HOA dues \$10.00 to meet expected expenses. Kenny gave 2 budget options for future of maintenance of roofs, roads, painting. He will continue working on the budget for expenses.

- On Friday, May 4, 2012 the architectural committee approved a change request submitted by Jan Pate. She requested a driveway extension and a sidewalk from her driveway to her courtyard.
- The architectural style of the homes in the Gardens at Heritage Green fall in the style known as "Craftsman". These homes feature simple details. Typically, only one color is used for the main surfaces with contrast used only on trim, shutters, or doors. Unfortunately, on some of the homes, the builder used a different color on the gables or other parts. This is not in keeping the traditional craftsman style. Therefore we would like to suggest the following: As the homes are repainted, all main surfaces are painted the same color, reserving contrast (which should be lighter than the main color) only for trim, shutters, and doors.
